	Control Measures to be taken for above Hazards / Risks:
1	Service vehicle driving around site, not exceeding 5mph taking due care of persons within the immediate vicinity and other stalls and equipment.
2	All 4 corners tied down with ratchets and pegs on grassed areas and weights and straps on hardstanding areas to secure stall/gazebo to ground to prevent tipping over in excessive strong winds.
3	Stock boxes having no more than 3kg in weight. Correct posture when lifting boxes.
4	All spillages to be mopped up immediately and area made safe, and all refuse placed into receptacle and to be removed to site waste container. When necessary.
5	All team members to be fully aware of risks and how to control them and to be adequately informed or trained where relevant.
6	Only FDA/EU approved products used, which complies with the recognised industry standard along with its code of practice. All products and equipment used must be suitable for their purpose and intended use.
